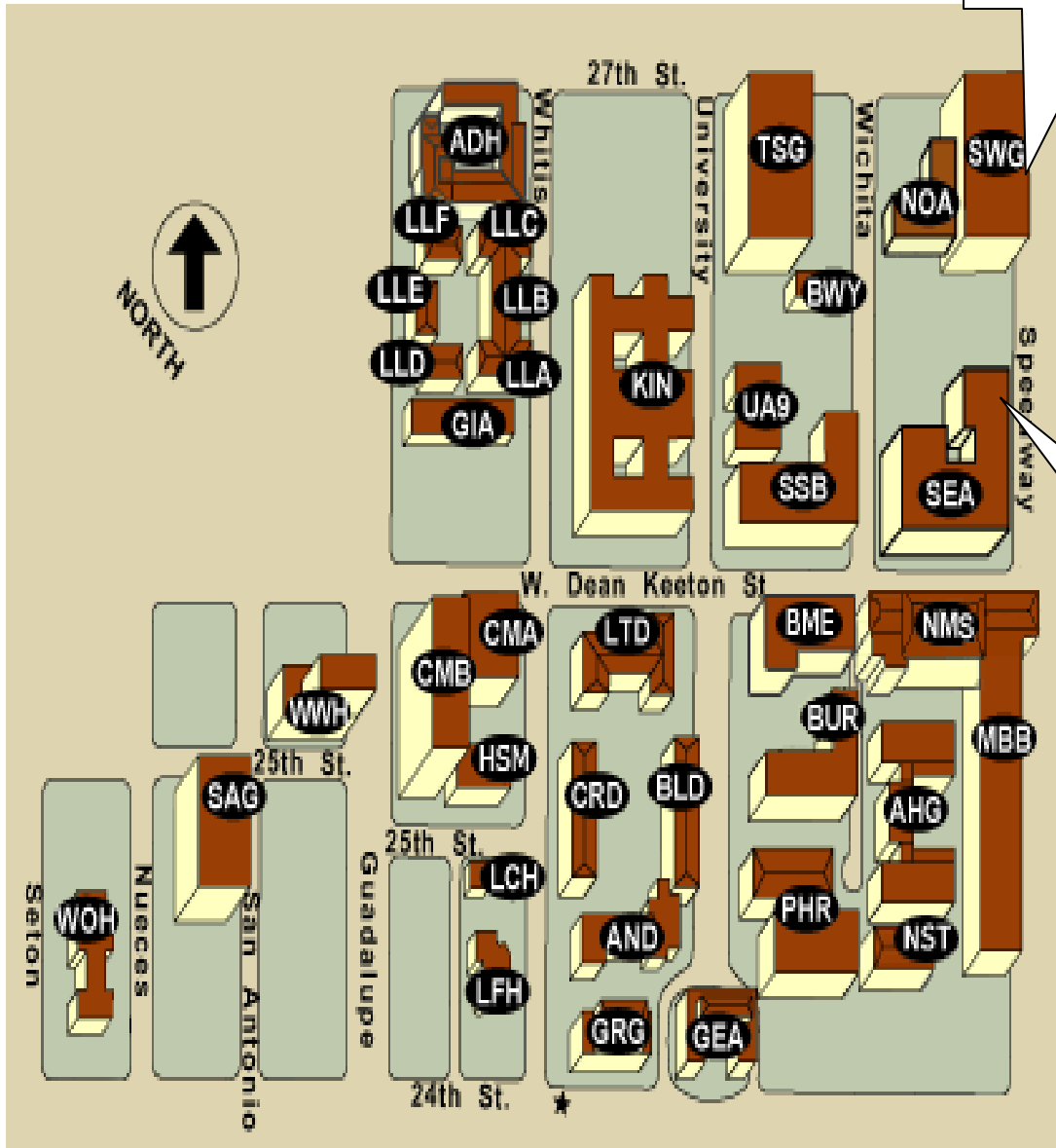


Our research rooms are located in the Seay Building (SEA) at the corner of W. Dean Keaton St and Speedway in the northwest area of the University of Texas campus.

Parking Garage (SWG) – Please park here. If you are scheduled for a session during the week (Mon – Fri), take a ticket at the entrance and bring it with you to the session. If you are scheduled for a weekend, a project member will meet you at the garage entrance to allow you entry.



Entrance to labs (SEA) - A research assistant will greet you here. These are the doors facing Speedway, nearest the playground.

How to Get to the Main Campus

The University of Texas at Austin is located in the heart of the city of Austin, just north of the downtown area. Campus is just two miles from the State Capitol. Main thoroughfares around campus include Guadalupe to the west, MLK to the south, Red River to the east and 26th (Dean Keeton) to the north.

IH-35

Take 26th Street (Dean Keeton Street) exit heading west. Turn right onto Speedway. The Seay Building and parking will be on your left.

MoPac/Highway 1

Take Windsor Road exit heading east. Turns into 24th Street, which dead-ends into Guadalupe Street. Turn left on Guadalupe Street, then turn right onto Dean Keeton. Make a left onto Speedway. The Seay Building and parking will be on your left.

Highway 71

From East, take I-35 North and follow directions for I-35 above. From West, take MoPac/Highway 1 North and follow directions for MoPac/Highway 1 above.

I-290

From East, take I-35 South and follow directions for I-35 above. From West, follow directions for Highway 71 above.

I-183

From North, take MoPac/Highway 1 South and follow directions for MoPac/Highway 1 above.
